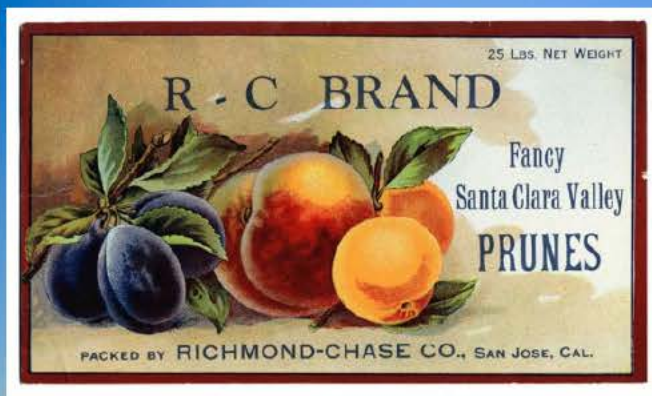

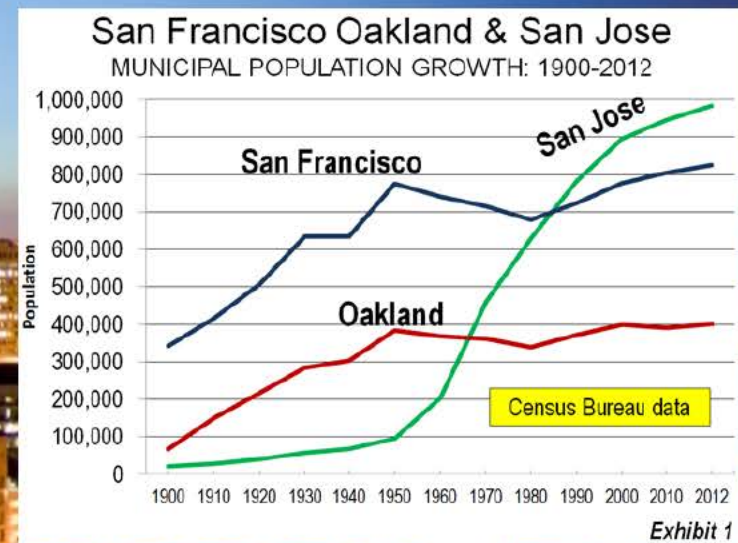
- San Jose held title for safest big city in the nation for a number of years
- San Jose has one of the fastest growing economy job growths in California as of 2016



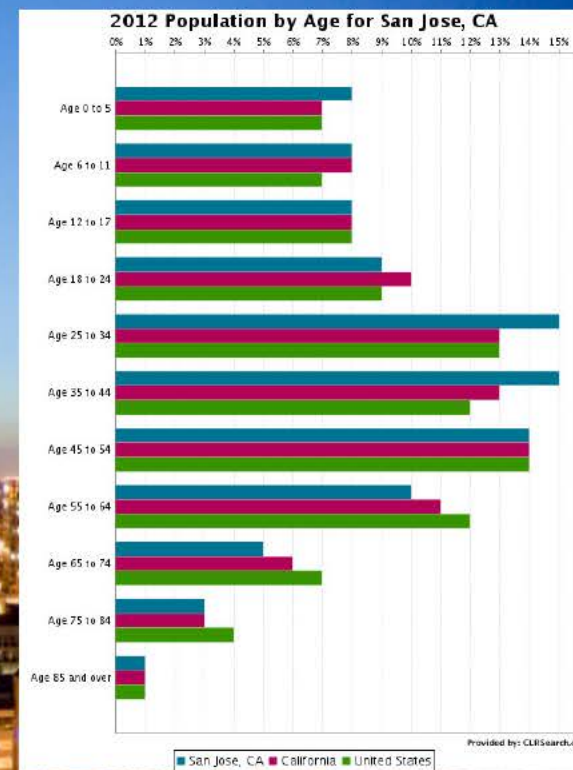
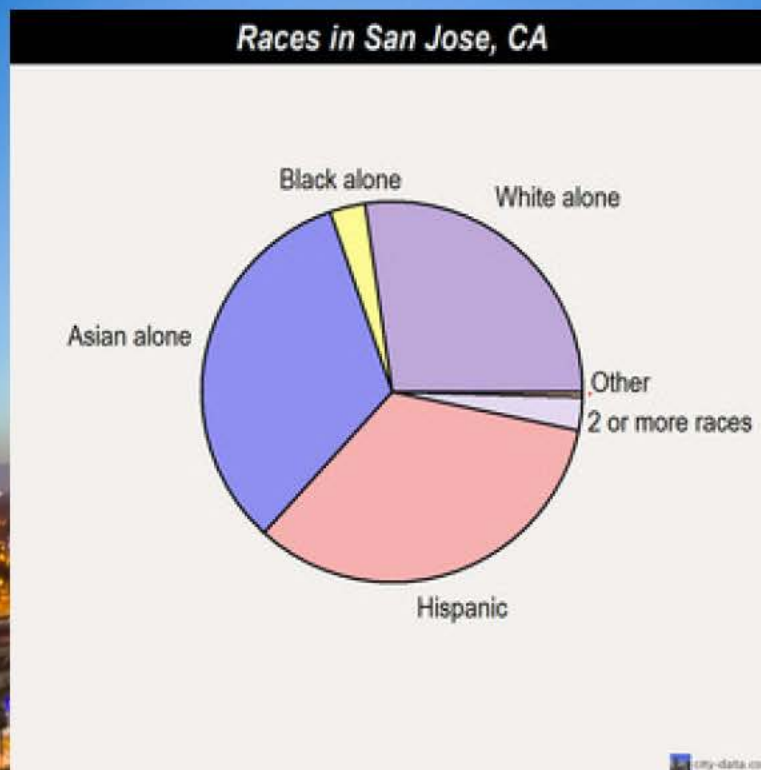
Introduction – Size and Population

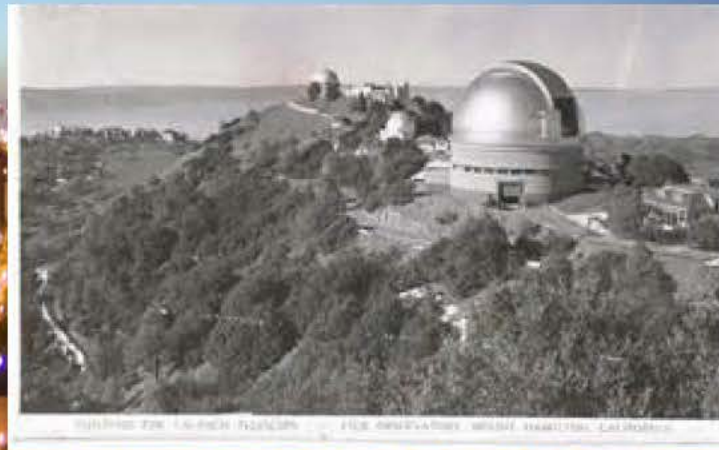

Maps & Street Numbering – Map Types

- San Jose Police Beat Maps
- SJFD Response Maps
- Large jurisdictional maps
- Barclay's Maps
- CAD Maps
- Internet maps



Maps & Street Numbering – Map Reading

- Top of the page is North unless otherwise indicated
- Use the legend, assigned scale, reference points
- Attributes of a street number:
 - Part of a mailing address
 - Numeric can indicate jurisdiction
 - Clue to location (ex. 200 block)
- Use NOW SEE
- Zero points:
 - North/South: Santa Clara, The Alameda
 - 100 digits per block
 - East/West: 1st street, Monterey
 - 50 digits per block

Maps & Street Numbering – Special Problems

- Postal addresses vs Jurisdictional boundaries
 - San Jose addresses in county jurisdiction
 - Campbell addresses in San Jose jurisdiction
- Direction of travel to determine district jurisdiction

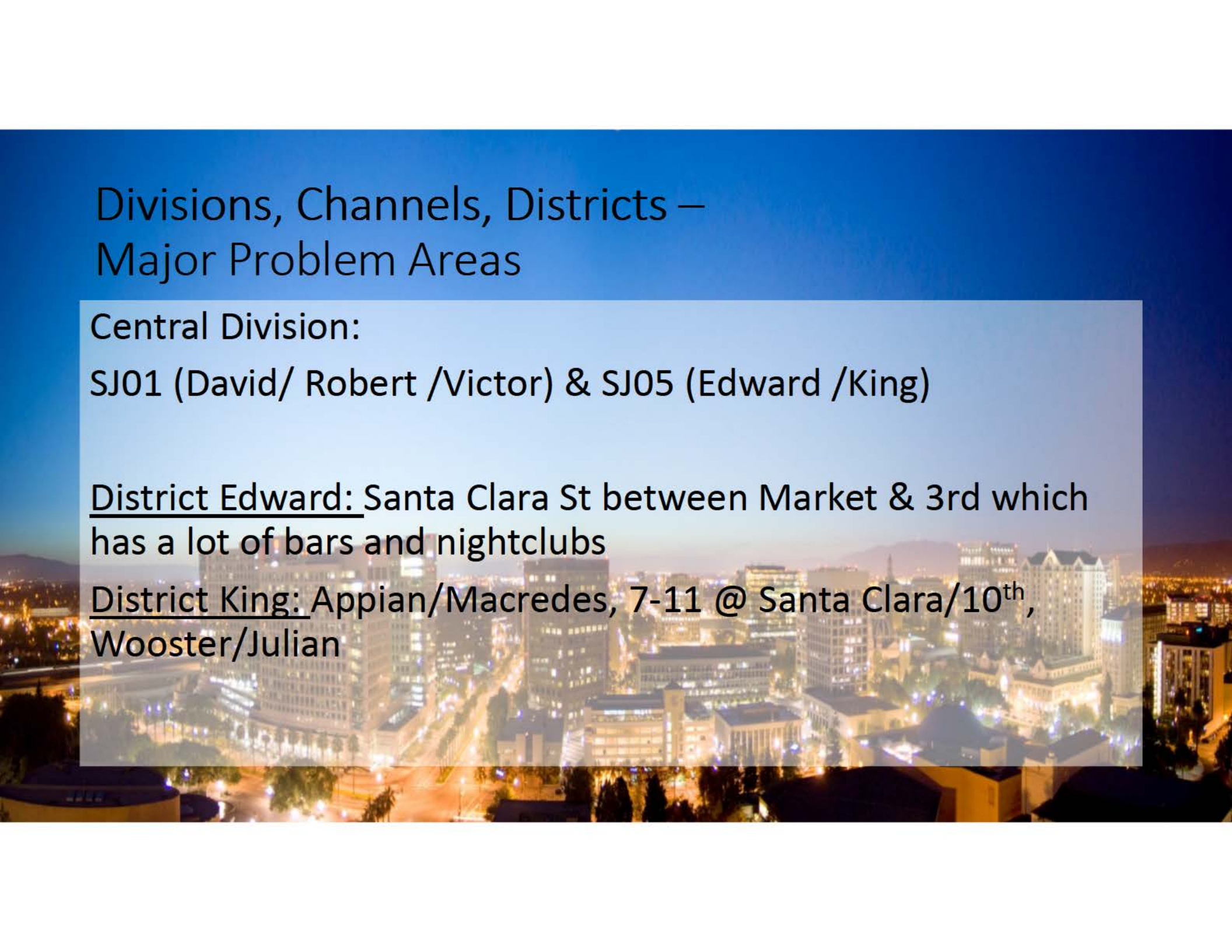

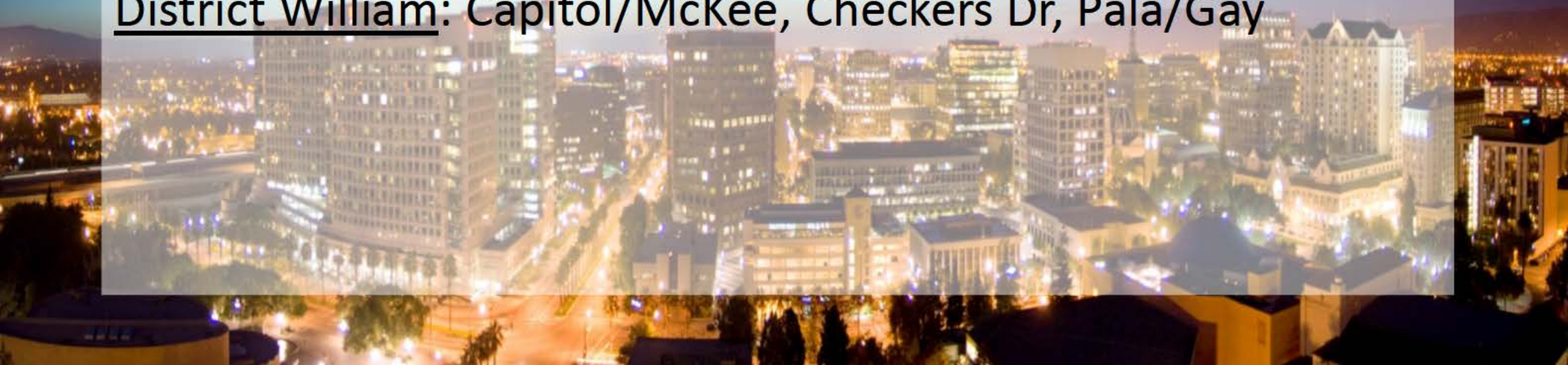

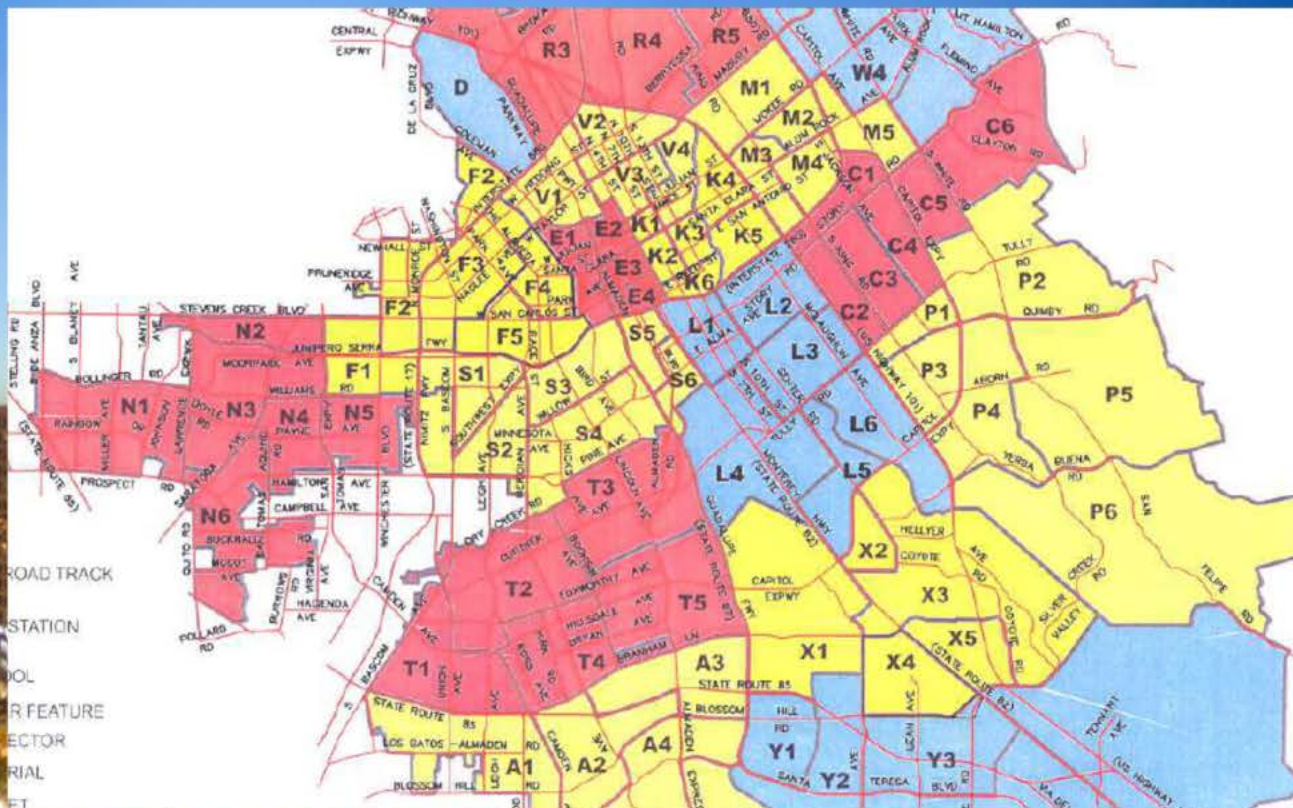

Beat Borders & Jurisdictional Concerns



Beat Borders

- Most boundaries between beats are streets (see Handout)
- If event is on a street/border, determine the direction of travel or side of the street
- Locations (including intersections that are borders) are automatically assigned a beat/district but you can and will override it if necessary
- Examples:
 - 242 at white/story
 - 1182 on SCB/Winchester

Jurisdictional Concerns – Unincorporated Areas

- Burbank area (mostly DF, F5): Bascom/W San Carlos
- Cambrian area (within T1): around Cambrian Plaza
- Coyote Valley: between southern San Jose and Morgan Hill
- East side area (around W3, W4, C6) : around Alum Rock/White



Jurisdictional Concerns – California Highway Patrol

- Highways/Freeways
- Onramps/Offramps
- Any school bus accident with students on board
- Traffic related incidents in unincorporated areas
- 1125CHP
- 1179CHP
- Some state buildings
 - Ex. DMV



Jurisdictional Concerns – Santa Clara County S/O

- Unincorporated areas within the City of San Jose
- Cupertino (contracted city)
- Saratoga (contracted city)
- Specific County Buildings and county owned property
 - Ex. VTA buses or light rail platforms (next slide)



Jurisdictional Concerns – Buses & Light Rail

- Light rail system and buses are run by the county
 - S/O has special Transit Patrol deputies
- At LRS or covered bus stops, it is the S/O's jurisdiction
- At uncovered bus stops or any accident on San Jose streets involving a bus or light rail train is SJPD's jurisdiction



Jurisdictional Concerns – CALTRAIN

- CALTRAIN Police is dispatched through the San Mateo County Sheriff's office dispatch
 - They are responsible for all crimes and disturbances onboard the CALTRAIN trains and stations
- SJPD is often dispatched and will contain the scene until CALTRAIN PD arrives due to long ETAs
