Memorial Day is observed on the last Monday in May, commemorating the men and women who died in the service of their country. Veterans Day is observed on November 11th every year, honoring those who have served in the United States Armed Forces.

Uniformed personnel who are current members of the Reserve Armed Forces, The National Guard, or who have been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces may wear these service ribbons on their uniforms during the business week prior to Veterans Day and Memorial Day, the day of Veterans Day and Memorial Day, and the business day immediately following Veterans Day and Memorial Day each year.

Ribbons worn on the uniform shall be affixed below the badge and above any Department medal or award. Ribbons worn on the dress coat shall be worn below the badge.

These changes will be reflected in the Department's Uniform Manual.
