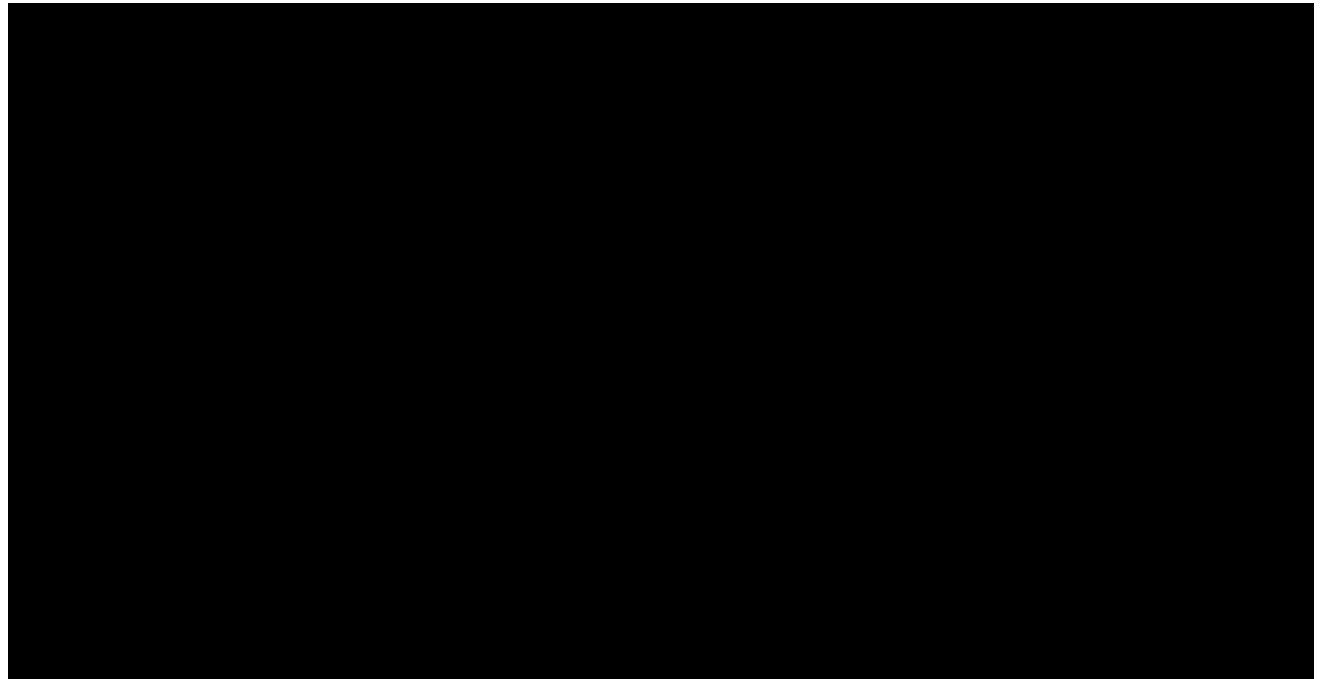

SUBJECT: EVENT CLEARANCE “UNHOUSED
RELATED” AND “PERCEIVED
DISABILITY” FIELDS

The *Event Clear* mask in Department MDTs requires officers to respond to two additional fields: “Unhoused Related” and “Perceived Disability” before successfully clearing an event.



“Unhoused Related”: If the event involved a person or persons suspected or confirmed to be unhoused, or if the event involved a geographic area occupied by an unhoused person, the officer should select the “Yes” option. Alternatively, the officer should select the “No” option.

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“Perceived Disability”: Utilizing a drop-down menu, officers should select the most appropriate perceived disability involved in or at the center of the event:

- None
- Mental Health Condition (MHC)
- Intellectual or Developmental Disability, including Dementia (DEV)
- Multiple Disabilities (MD)
- Blind or Limited Vision (BLIND)
- Deafness or Difficulty Hearing (DEAF)
- Speech Impairment or Limited Use of Language (SI)
- Hyperactivity (HYP)
- Other disability (O)

Officers will not be able to clear events on Department MDTs without completing both the “Unhoused Related” and “Perceived Disability” fields.
