- > Winter time = Warm ups








# (VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER)


- Located throughout the vehicle
- 1970 All passenger cars had a visible Vin in window and Federal Label inside Driver's side Door
- 1980 All light duty trucks had a visible VIN in window
- Manufacturers are responsible for Vin configuration = no uniformity
- Only thing regulated is all vehicles have a 17 digit VIN





# NARRATIVE (STOLEN)

On I was dispatched to the area of in San Jose regarding a report of a stolen vehicle.


# NARRATIVE (RECOVERY)

On hours, I was dispatched to the area of in San Jose regarding a previously reported stolen vehicle that had been located by the registered owner.


