### DETAILS:

In December 2002, a pastor from the North Valley Christian Fellowship Church in San Jose, called the San Jose Police Dept. to report that he had heard allegations that a youth group leader for the church had molested a teenage boy. Detective Jonathan Kaiser from our Child Exploitation Detail began an investigation into the allegation.

Detective Kaiser learned that the suspect, Bradley Schrader, was a member of this church for a number of years. He was selected as a youth group leader and served in that capacity for approximately four years. As a youth group leader he would often invite groups of teenage boys to his apartment on McKee Rd. to do homework together. Sometime later he began inviting young boys to his home on more social visits and later even allowed some of the boys to spend the night, with their parents' permission, at his apartment.

Detective Kaiser was able to identify and interview the teenage boy (Victim #1) that had made the allegation against the suspect. He learned that the victim had spent the night at the suspect's apartment. He told Detective Kaiser that the suspect had touched him inappropriately while he slept on the couch (he said that he woke up as this was taking place). Follow-up investigation by Detective Kaiser identified two additional victims in this case. Both of those victims told the Detective that the suspect had touched them inappropriately while they slept in his apartment.

Detective Kaiser submitted his case to the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office. A \$40,000 felony arrest warrant was issued for the suspect charging one count of child molestation (felony) and two counts of child annoyance (misdemeanor). Detective Kaiser learned that the suspect had recently moved out of state. He was able to locate an address for the suspect in Laramie, Wyoming. On 3-30-04, Flint Waters, the agent-in-charge of the Wyoming Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force, arrested the suspect on our outstanding warrant. He has been booked into jail in Laramie and is expected to be extradited back to Santa Clara County.
