### **DETAILS:**

On 6-17-04 at 10:00PM, Detectives from the San Jose Police Dept.'s Sexual Registrant Enforcement Team arrested Cary Verse at his residence in South San Jose. He was arrested for failing to update his registration as a sexual offender.

Under California law, Mr. Verse is required to register with the local law enforcement agency at least every ninety days as a sexually violent predator. He arrived in San Jose on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2004 and did register with the San Jose Police Dept. at that time. He was interviewed by Sexual Assault Detectives at that time and warned that he would be closely monitored.

Cary Verse was required to re-register no later than June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2004. When he failed to do so, Detectives contacted the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office. They agreed that Mr. Verse was in violation and subject to arrest. Detectives then went to the Mission Motel on Monterey Rd. and arrested Mr. Verse. He was processed at the San Jose Police Dept. and booked into Santa Clara County Jail for one felony count of failing to update his registration as a sex offender.
