DETAILS:

On 9-15-04 the San Jose Police Department received information that an adult basketball coach was having sexual relations with a juvenile female. Detective Robert Dillon of our Child Exploitation Detail began an investigation into those allegations.

The investigation disclosed that the suspect was the coach of the East Bay Xplosion summer basketball program. The victim was a player on the team. The team would play games throughout California and other states. It is believed that the suspect began an inappropriate relationship with the victim during one of those trips outside of California. The investigation indicates that the relationship continued to develop to include sexual contact between the suspect and victim.

Detective Dillon submitted his case to the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office. A one million dollar arrest warrant has been issued for the suspect charging three felony sex crimes. Arrangements to have the suspect surrender have not been successful.

Based on his investigation, Detective Dillon is concerned that there may be additional victims in this case that have not yet been identified. In addition to coaching the East Bay Xplosion, the suspect also coaches basketball at St. Mary's College High School in Berkeley.
