DETAILS:

On November 11, 2004, at 9:11 PM, Murillo entered the liquor store while Solis was acting as a lookout outside. Three juvenile suspects waited in a red 1985 Honda Prelude. Murillo approached the counter armed with a handgun and confronted two clerks. Murillo shot one of the clerks multiple times and fled the scene in the Honda.

At 9:32 PM, Officer Merlin Newton saw the car with five occupants on N. 24th St. and Melbourne Ave. Officer Newton attempted to stop the car, but it failed to yield. During the pursuit, the car stopped momentarily, Solis exited and fled. Solis has not been apprehended.

The pursuit lasted approximately 28 minutes. The pursuit was terminated as a result of legal intervention by police vehicles at McKee Ave. and N. 33rd St. There were no additional accidents or injuries. Murillo fled on foot. Officers chased Murillo and apprehended him. The other occupants were also taken into custody.
