DETAILS:

On Friday, December 3, 2004 at about 7:09 AM, an Armed Courier Service guard flagged down San Jose Police Officer Mark Riles on Senter Rd. and Capitol Expressway. The guard, who was in uniform and armed, informed Officer Riles that he encountered two men inside the AM/PM Mini Market and recognized them from a flyer involving a robbery that occurred at another AM/PM Mini Market in the City of Campbell on November 5, 2004.

While the guard provided details to Officer Riles, the suspects walked away from the market. As Officer Riles and the guard approached the suspects, the suspects tossed two handguns. Officer Riles did an outstanding job coordinating the successful apprehension of both suspects.

Campbell and San Jose Police detectives conducted a joint investigation. Detectives determined the suspects were about to commit an armed robbery today at the AM/PM Mini Market. In addition, they were able to link the suspects to the AM/PM Mini Market robbery that occurred in Campbell (1860 W. Campbell Ave).
