### **DETAILS:**

On Saturday, April 23, 2005 at 3:16PM, a bank robbery occurred at the Wells Fargo Bank at 1705 North 1<sup>st</sup> Street, San Jose. The suspect approached the bank teller and demanded money. The suspect fled the bank with an undisclosed amount of cash. No vehicle was seen.

On Saturday, May 7, 2005 at 4:00PM, a bank robbery occurred at the Wells Fargo Bank at 191 Branham Lane, San Jose. The suspect approached the bank teller and demanded money. He told the bank teller that he had a gun, although none was seen. The suspect fled. No vehicle was seen.

The suspect in both cases was described as an Asian Male adult, mid 30's, 5'7 to 5'9, thin build, with black hair and brown eyes. On 04-23-05, he was wearing a dark jacket, dark shirt with "Nautica" across the chest and blue jeans. On 05-07-05, he was wearing a black "Nike" baseball cap, white T-shirt, blue jeans and white tennis shoes.

It is believed that the same suspect robbed both of these banks. He is also suspected in a third bank robbery, which occurred on 05-07-05 at the Wells Fargo in Morgan Hill at 17590 Monterey Road.

Wells Fargo Bank is offering a \$10,000. Dollar reward for any information leading to the arrest
