### **DETAILS:**

On Thursday, May 19, 2005, at 3:18AM, San Jose Police Officers responded on a traffic collision involving a car and pedestrian at Capitol Expressway and Tuers Rd.

Preliminary investigation indicates the victim was not in a crosswalk as she walked across Capitol Expressway. A red 4-door 2002 Toyota Corolla traveling in the #3 eastbound lane of Capitol Expressway struck the victim. The victim died at the scene. There is no indication of drug or alcohol influence.

We are asking for the public's help in identifying the victim. The victim is a black female, 19-25 years old, with long dark curly hair in a ponytail, wearing sandals, blue jeans and a corduroy jacket. The victim also has a tattoo of a rose on her left shoulder.
