DETAILS:

On 11/21/05 at 11:12AM, San Jose Police Officers responded on an injury accident involving an Amtrak train and a pedestrian at Monterey Rd. and Blossom Hill Rd. On arrival, officers located an injured child on the tracks. The child was pronounced dead at the scene.

Detectives have determined that the Amtrak train was traveling southbound on Monterey Rd. under Blossom Hill Rd. The victim was walking eastbound across the tracks with his brother, babysitter and an infant child. The babysitter crossed back over the tracks to retrieve a stroller she left on the west side of the tracks. The victim followed behind and was struck by the train.
