DETAILS:

On Sunday, May 14, 2006, at 9:20 PM, San Jose Police Officers responded to a major injury traffic collision involving a car and a pedestrian on Capitol Expressway and Ocala Ave.

Preliminary investigation indicates the victim was crossing Capitol Expressway. Venancio was driving a 1998 black Toyota Camry 4-door N/B Capitol Expressway in the #2 when his car struck the victim. The victim was not in a crosswalk. The victim was pronounced dead at the scene.

There is no indication that speed was a factor. In addition, there is no indication of drug or alcohol influence on the part of the driver.

The Santa Clara County Coroner's Office is asking for the public's help in identifying the victim in this case.

The victim is described as a HMA, 25-35 years old, with a thin moustache, black hair and brown eyes, approximately 5'-3" in height, weighing approximately 150 pounds, and wearing a plaid flannel shirt, black jeans and black boots. The victim had a wallet but no identification. He has scars on his right temple, left elbow, left lower leg. Preliminary fingerprint analysis failed to identify the victim, although those efforts are continuing.
