DETAILS:

On 5/27/06 at 10:50PM, San Jose Police Officers responded on a call of a stabbing in the 1200 block of Santee Dr. On arrival, officers located two male stabbing victims. Victim #1 was pronounced dead at the scene. Victim #2 sustained minor injuries and declined medical attention.

Homicide Detectives and Crime Scene Technicians responded to the scene. Preliminary investigation shows that the two victims were attending a party on Santee Dr. The victims were out in front of the residence when the two suspects confronted them. A verbal altercation occurred that escalated into a physical fight. During the fight Suspect #1 pulled out a knife and stabbed both victims. Both suspects were last seen running from the scene. A motive has not been established for this case.

UPDATE:

Follow-up investigation by Homicide Detectives identified a sixteen-year old suspect in this case. The suspect was on a weekend pass from the James Boys Ranch in Morgan Hill when he allegedly stabbed the victims. Detectives arrested him on 5-30-06 at 3:00PM and booked him into Juvenile Hall for murder. Detectives are still searching for a second suspect in this case.
