Over the past four days, there have been several robberies which appear to have been committed by the same suspect. A composite description identifies the suspect as a black male adult with a dark complexion, 18-25 years of age, 5'-9" to 6'-0" in height, weighing between 140-160 pounds, described as thin but muscular. He has worn different clothing in each case.

It appears that the victims in this series have been targeted through the use of Craig's List, an on-line Internet community of classified ads and forums. In each case, the victim was either buying something from or selling something to the suspect. In every case the suspect has robbed the victims at gunpoint before making off with property and cash.
