Chief Rob Davis and the San Jose Police Department are proud to announce the appointment of our new Assistant Chief of Police. Effective Sunday, 8-28-05, Captain Charles "Tuck" Younis will assume his new role as the Department's Assistant Chief of Police, taking over for recently retired Chief Dewey Hosmer.

Assistant Chief Younis has served for over 26 years on the San Jose Police Department, joining the agency in 1978. He has served in a variety of positions, most currently overseeing the Special Operations Division in the Bureau of Field Operations, where he was responsible for the MERGE (SWAT and Canine) teams, Violent Crimes Enforcement Team (VCET), METRO Unit (responsible for street-level narcotics enforcement), Horse Mounted Unit (HMU), Air Support Unit, and the Traffic Enforcement Unit (TEU). He also oversaw the Department's coordination of services for the recent premiere of the San Jose Grand Prix race.

As a lieutenant, Younis served as a commander of the Special Investigations Unit (Vice), Special Operations commander, and patrol supervisor.

As a sergeant, Younis served as a Field Training supervisor, BFO Administrative Unit supervisor, and Internal Affairs investigator.

As an officer, Younis served as a Field Training Officer, Vice investigator, Organized Crime investigator, and patrol officer.

Assistant Chief Younis received his Bachelor of Arts Degree in Community Services from California State University, Chico in 1979.
