**\$5,000 reward offered in the Bruce Lee
Homicide case of August 13th, 2006
bringing the total reward to \$6,000**

DETAILS:

On 8-13-06 at 11:49PM, San Jose Police Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Tully Road, west of McLaughlin Avenue, to reports of a man down, the victim of an apparent shooting. Several suspects, wearing dark clothing, were seen running from the store. At 11:53PM, Police Communications was advised that the victim was pronounced dead at the scene. Homicide Detectives have not yet determined a motive in this case.

The Carole Sund/Carrington Foundation is offering a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and successful prosecution of the suspect(s) in this case. Crime Stoppers is adding an additional \$1,000 for the same information.

*“Carole and Juli Sund and Silvina Pelosso were the three women sightseers who were missing and later found murdered near Yosemite National Park in February of 1999. While they were missing, Carole Sund’s parents, Francis and Carole Carrington, at the request of the FBI, posted rewards both for their safe return and for information leading to the whereabouts of their rental car. The Carringtons believe that the posting of these rewards and the media attention they received, contributed to the car being located and gave them the first break in their case. They were thankful that they had the financial means to offer these rewards and it is because of this that they have started **The Carole Sund/Carrington Foundation**. This foundation was established to assist families such as the family of **Bruce Lee** who are in similar circumstances as the Carrington’s in that **Bruce** is a victim of homicide.*

The Carole Sund/Carrington Foundation is offering a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the death of Bruce Lee. We know reward money can make a difference because the Foundation’s reward money has already assisted in the apprehension of thirty-six murder suspects, one child molester/attempted murderer, one kidnapper/child molester and helped to locate nine missing persons. We currently have suspects in custody in eight states. Of the twenty-nine suspects in custody, eight murderers and one child molester/attempted murderer have been convicted or plead guilty as charged. To date, the Foundation has paid a total of \$247,500 in rewards to citizens who did the right thing by coming forward and sharing the information they had regarding these cases. We all have a responsibility to do our part to help make our community a safe place. So, please if you know anything about this case, call **SERGEANT TOM MORALES OF THE SAN JOSE POLICE DEPARTMENT. THANK YOU.**

San Jose Police Chief Rob Davis adds, *“I would like to pass along my sincere thanks to The Carole Sund/Carrington Foundation for establishing this reward fund in Mr. Lee’s name. It has been our experience that reward funds have been the catalyst to increased interest and investigative leads in cases like that of Mr. Lee. We hope that will be the case here. I strongly urge anyone with information to contact our investigators.”*
