### **Armed Robbery/ Attempted Armed Robbery**

**Case Numbers:** 04-087-1153  
04-093-0969

**SUSPECT #1:** African-American male adult, 20-25 years, 6', thin to medium build, dark eyes, wearing a black beanie cap and a bandana over his face. This suspect is armed with a handgun.

**SUSPECT #2:** Hispanic Male adult, 21-22 years, 5'9" to 6', medium build, wearing a dark baseball cap, with a bandana over his face.

**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** Possibly a dark green Honda 4-door sedan

#### **DETAILS:**

On Saturday, 3-27-04 at 10:28PM, the two suspects entered the Pizza Hut at 5475 Snell Ave. Suspect #1 brandished a handgun and jumped over the counter demanding money from the employees, while suspect #2 watched the customers. Once the manager gave the suspects the money from the business, they demanded money from the customers. The suspects then decided against robbing the customers and fled from the store.

On Thursday, 4-1-04 at 10:00PM, Suspect #2 approached the Pizza Hut at 4605 Cherry Ave. He tried to get in but the door was locked. The suspect tried to convince an employee to open the door. When the employee refused, suspect #1 got out of the suspect's vehicle and approached the store with a handgun in his hand. The employee ran for cover and the suspects fled in their vehicle.

San Jose Police Robbery Detectives are trying to identify these suspects and get them into custody before they commit any further crimes. They are considered to be armed and dangerous. They usually hit on or near the weekends and always late at night, just before closing time. It is believed that they spend some time in their vehicle in the parking lot outside of these businesses before they commit their robberies.
